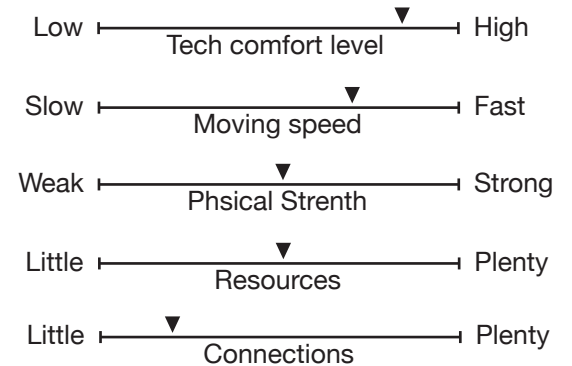
Objectives
